

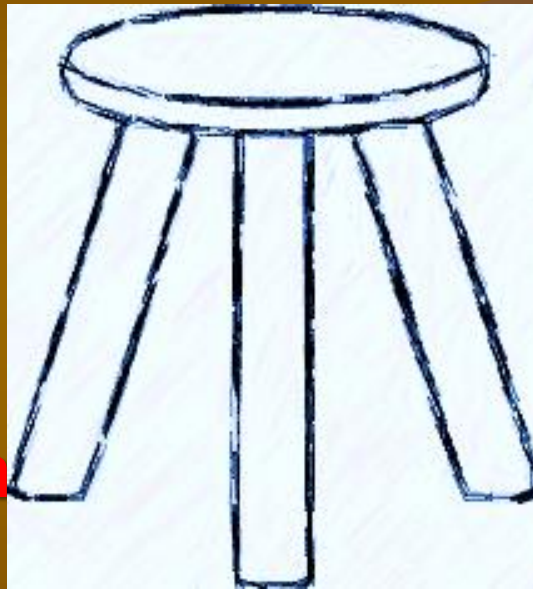


Primary Functions of SEED


